Re: Electoral Arrangements in Wales

Further to your letter dated 2 June, enclosing your consultation document on the above, Llangedwyn Community Council would like to make the following comments:

- 1) Question 3 – we agree with individual identification to help increase registration
- 2) Question 6 – we disagree with all postal voting, as we consider it opens the system to abuse
- 3) Question 7 – We do not support electronic voting at the present time, as we consider it would complicate the process at polling stations
- 4) Question 8 – we consider that in a very small community such as ours, one polling post is sufficient.
- 5) Question 11 – we consider that the system of government should be taught in schools, but not party politics, as it would be very difficult to do this in a totally unbiased way
- 6) Question 12 – we believe that political parties should not be involved in the school.
